Puzzle 0438: Get from **ROUND** to **ABOUT** in 14 steps or less.

	R	O	U	N	D	Circular or spherical; having no sharp corners or edges; rounded; around.
1.	B	O	U	N	D	Past tense of <i>bind</i> , to tie together; past tense of <i>boun</i> to make ready or oblige.
2.	B	O	U	N	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>boun</i> to make ready or oblige to carry out a course of action.
3.	B	O	U	T	S	Plural of <i>bout</i> , an episode, an organised fight.
4.	B	O	O	T	S	Plural of <i>boot</i> , a heavy closed shoe; 3rd p. sing. of <i>boot</i> , to kick, to dismiss (colloq.).
5.	S	O	O	T	S	Plural of <i>soot</i> , substance produced by fire, 3rd p. sing. of <i>soot</i> , to cover in soot.
6.	S	P	O	T	S	Plural of <i>spot</i> , small area of different appearance, or place; 3rd p. sing. of <i>spot</i> , see.
7.	S	P	A	T	S	Garments worn around the ankle covering top of the shoe; plural of <i>spat</i> , a quarrel.
8.	S	P	A	T	E	A surge; a sudden rush or increase; an outbreak.
9.	S	P	A	R	E	Extra or additional; to refrain or allow.
10.	S	P	O	R	E	Single cell reproductive unit of fungi, algae and plants; dormant state of bacterium.

2.	S	I	G	H	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>sigh</i> , breathe a sound; plural of <i>sigh</i> , sound like that made by sighing.
3.	S	I	T	H	S	Staten Island Technical High School.
4.	S	I	T	E	S	Plural of <i>site</i> , a location; 3rd p. sing. of <i>site</i> , to place in position or at a location.
5.	S	I	R	E	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>sire</i> , to father; Plural of <i>sire</i> , father or seigneur.
6.	S	O	R	E	S	Plural of <i>sore</i> , an inflamed or infected injury or ulcer.
7.	S	O	R	T	S	Plural of <i>sort</i> , type or category; 3rd p. sing. of <i>sort</i> , to put in order or groups.
8.	S	O	O	T	S	Plural of <i>soot</i> , substance produced by fire, 3rd p. sing. of <i>soot</i> , to cover in soot.
9.	S	L	O	T	S	Plural of <i>slot</i> , an elongated aperture.
10.	S	L	I	T	S	Plural of <i>slit</i> , narrow opening or slot; 3rd p. sing of <i>slit</i> , cut through in a single stroke.
11.	F	L	I	T	S	3rd p. sing of <i>flit</i> to move or change erratically, rapidly or suddenly, to move house.
12.	F	L	I	E	S	Plural of <i>fly</i> , a winged insect; 3rd p. sing of <i>fly</i> , travel in the air or progress rapidly.
13.	F	R	I	E	S	3rd p. sing of <i>fry</i> , cook in oil or fat; colloquialism for <i>French fried potatoes</i> .
14.	F	R	E	E	S	3rd p. sing. of <i>free</i> , to liberate.
15.	F	R	E	E	D	Past tense of <i>free</i> , to liberate.
16.	G	R	E	E	D	A selfish or excessive desire; avarice.
17.	G	R	E	E	N	Primary colour; unripe; uncured; inexperienced; ecologically friendly; grassy area.
